City of Marshall Adopt-a-Park Rules and Regulations

In order to enhance the quality of our parks, the City of Marshall Department of Public Works encourages volunteers to assist with litter pickup, preservation and maintenance of landscaped areas, increased landscaping, and general upkeep and repair of equipment and facilities.

The Adopt-A-Park Program allows for individuals or groups to adopt a specific park. Through adoption, these individuals or groups may assume the responsibility for any or all of the eligible activities, which will lead to:

- Reduce litter in parks
- Enhancement of the environment
- Beautification of the green space
- Broad-based community support

Potential Adopt-A-Park Activities

The following activities are eligible to be included in Adopt-A-Park sponsorship:

- Litter control
- Landscape maintenance
- Routine maintenance
- Facility and equipment improvement
- Other improvement ideas as suggested

Program Requirements

The City of Marshall Department of Public Works ("Department") will work with the adopting group ("Sponsor") to determine the specific park to be adopted. Street medians and other green space areas may be eligible for sponsorship.

The main focus of the program is litter control. The Sponsor will agree to pick up litter in the adopted park at least 3 times a year. Other activities such as plantings, repair projects, and installation of new equipment must be approved by the Department. Lawn care may also be assigned to Sponsors with smaller parks.

The Sponsor must submit an annual report of the number of the people that work in the park and the hours worked.

The Sponsor shall carry on the work as required and authorized by the agreement with serious regard to the safety of the traveling public, adjacent property owners and volunteers or employees of the sponsor. The sponsor agrees to instruct their volunteers in safety precautions.

The Sponsor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Marshall, its officers, agents and employees from all liability, judgment cost, expenses and claims growing out of damages, or alleged damages of any nature whatsoever to any person or property

arising from the performance or non-performance of the sponsor's Adopt-a-Park agreement, sponsorship, sponsorship activities or work.

Sponsorship will be applied annually. A Sponsor that has performed to an acceptable standard will be given preference when renewing.

If in the sole judgment of the department, it is found that the sponsor is not meeting the terms and conditions of the agreement, the Department may terminate the agreement and remove the sponsorship signs.

Individuals who participate in this program must be at least 16 years of age or under adult supervision.

Sponsor Responsibilities

- Complete and submit an application
- Send a representative to the parks and recreation advisory board meeting when application action is taken
- Obtain supplies and materials from the Department during regular business hours 7:30am to 4pm. Monday Friday
- Work in a safe manner
- Insure youth participates are furnished with adequate adult supervision
- Notify the Department of any issues that need Department attention or repair, especially when safety is concerned
- Report annually the names, hours, and job functions of the people that participated in the Adopt-a-Park program.

Department Responsibilities

- Erecting a sign with the sponsor's name (donations for the cost of the sign from the Sponsor maybe accepted)
- Provide reporting forms
- Supplying trash bags
- Removing filled trash bags
- Following up on issues that are reported by Sponsor



- Peace Park (South side of W. Michigan Avenue between S. Grand Street and S. Eagle Street
- High Street Lot Landscape Maintenance
- Garvin Park (Union Street between N. Linden St and N. Mulberry Street)

- Hanover Place (S. Marshall Avenue and Exchange Street) Landscape maintenance
