- The card will be punched for every visit to the site, even for multiple visits on the same day.
- Punch Cards can be purchased at the City Hall Finance Dept. and Welcome Center or by mail see below. The Welcome Center is open on Saturday and Sunday's.
- Punch Cards will be available for purchase beginning Monday March 26, 2018.
- The City will not replace any lost cards.
- Township residents and contractors will not be allowed to use the compost site.
