### **SUMMARY**

Responsible for the construction, operation and maintenance of overhead and underground electric distribution lines and services that are energized at electric distribution voltages. Responds and manages electric utility power outage service restoration. Repairs street/parking lot lights, and installs/removes holiday decorations.

### **PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSABILITIES**

*(An\* denotes duties or responsibilities judged to be "essential functions" in terms of the Americans With Disabilities Act or ADA)*

- Constructs overhead and underground electric distribution systems, and transformer banks. \*
- Performs hands-on maintenance on electric lines that are energized at electric distribution voltages. \*
- Connects and disconnects services to customers. \*
- Rebuilds distribution lines following power outages. \*
- Maintains equipment. \*
- Repairs street and parking lot lights. \*
- Stocks Electric Department vehicles. \*
- Installs and removes holiday decorations. \*
- Extracts transformer oil samples for PCB analysis. \*
- Provides input for the development of safe work practices and procedures for the Electric Line Distribution Department. \*
- Other duties as assigned.

The above statements are intended to describe the general nature and level of work being performed by a person in this position. They are not to be construed as an exhaustive list of all job duties that may be performed by such a person.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

**Education:** Minimum - High school graduate. Must have successfully completed a certified Electric Utility Apprenticeship program.

**Experience:** Minimum- Between three and five years of progressively more responsible or expansive experience in electric utility systems operations, maintenance and construction is required.

**Other Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:** Specialized equipment operation, proper line and wire handling. Thorough understanding and knowledge of electricity. Communications skills.

The qualifications listed above are guidelines for selection purposes; alternative qualifications may be substituted if sufficient to perform the duties of the job.

## **CERTIFICATION OR LICENSURE**

A valid, Michigan driver's license with CDL endorsement.  
State of Michigan aerial lift device license.  
Journeyman Certification.

## **SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

Periodic exposure to moderate and sometimes extremely disagreeable working conditions during the course of daily work. Exposure to weather, potential injury, and contaminants.
