On June 5th, the Council adopted the Michigan Medical BACKGROUND: Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act ordinance. Since the adoption, MAEDA and City staff have received multiple inquiries on locating MMMFLA facilities. The current ordinance has a 5,280 foot distance between facilities.
