4) SEMI-ANNUAL INFORMATIONAL MEETING

- A. Financials: Jon Bartlett discussed with Board Members the written REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE REPORT FOR THE CITY OF MARSHALL for the PERIOD ENDING 09/30/2020. Total Revenues for the Amended 2020-21 Budget equal \$453,244.00, of which \$450,000.00 is an estimate of Bond Proceeds to be used for Capital Outlay. See Attachment A for the complete report.

B. Update on Alwyn Downs Development: Aided by maps, drawings, and pictures, Sean LeFere detailed the progress that has been made since April 2020 to "value engineer" the development. Different housing options will appeal to diverse groups of potential customers. Desirable house sizes are scaled to their matching lot size. Mr. LeFere estimates that, while preserving nearly the entirety of the initially projected project value, this process will halve necessary road lineage and other infrastructure costs. First development focus continues to be upon 19 already platted lots; current analysis is that these are best developed into 38 two-story duplexes. The golf course is currently operating. Plans for its improvement, along with outdoor catering and other community events; sidewalk extension and connections; paths and green spaces, have received positive public feedback. In addition to single family and duplex residences, multi-family units are also being considered, with attention being given to ensuring that their initial value is preserved and maintained over time.
